Dear Parents,

Unfortunately we are back at "Learning from Home" until notified otherwise.

We really appreciate your support in keeping your children at home and supervising the learning we have set for them.

Every child will receive a Learning Package along with some online activities to be completed at home, or at school for children with both parents classified as essential workers.

This Learning Package must be accessible by the child at school and home. Therefore we ask that at the end of each day, the package must be placed inside their school bag with all work finished or not. This way your child is prepared for learning if circumstances change unexpectedly.

Please note: Students at school will not be receiving lessons from their teachers. They will be supervised in completing work in their packages.

No Parent/Carer is allowed on school grounds or premises.

If any child is unwell, showing symptoms, they need to remain at home. Any student with any COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home and should not return to school until they have received a negative test result and are symptom free. In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms such as rhinitis, a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.

Contact to the school must be made by either telephone or email only.

Student Home Learning Packages can be picked up from school tomorrow. Please ring or email the office to indicate the time you will pick up your child's package. These packages will then be left out on the table at the front of school at the Arbour Gate.
