Student Learning Resources: Today with this newsletter you will receive an account indicating a breakdown of costs for your child's learning at school. We hope that these can be addressed as soon as possible to allow our accounts to be settled.

Cross Country Carnival: The annual combined Cross Country Carnival will be held here, at Middle Dural on Wednesday 6th May 2020. It would be a good time for our students to start to build up their stamina.... Start jogging/ exercising so that you can make the distance comfortably.

Attendance: It is a requirement that all students are in attendance every school day. If your child is unwell, we ask that you please notify the school by ringing or emailing, if possible, and that a written note confirming this absence is sent upon the student's return. Any absence due to illness longer than 2 days will require a doctor's certificate. Late arrivals and early departures are required to be signed in/out at the front office by the parent/carer.

School Hours: The bell rings at 9:00am each day for a 9:05 start. Students are allowed to be dropped off at school from 8:35am each day. The school bell rings at 3:05pm. Parents are asked to pick up their children at this time. No child is allowed to play after school and the play equipment is completely out of bounds to children before and after school. All students waiting for pick-up are requested to wait on the K/1/2 verandah where they can be sheltered and supervised until they leave.

Road Safety: The parking and traffic rules around our schools are there to protect your children. Parents and Caregivers need to take extra care when driving and parking in school zones. Make sure that you and your child understand the road rules. If you break the traffic rules in a school zone you are putting not only your child but other children at risk. If you break the rules you will be fined. Attached to the newsletter is information regarding the parking and traffic rules in a school zone. Please model safe and considerate behavior for your child—they will learn from you.
