COVID 19: New information is coming out daily. We ask that you do take this situation seriously. If your child presents with any respiratory problems please keep them at home until they are better and seek medical advice.

Assemblies: Thank you for your attendance at last week's assembly around our theme of Reasoning Skills. Again it is unfortunate that we will be unable to present any more assemblies this term due to the restrictions in place regarding social distancing and COVID 19.

Camp: The department of Education has called for all school excursions and camps to be cancelled. As such the camp will not be happening this year for our students.

Cross Country Carnival: The annual combined Cross Country Carnival was to be held here, at Middle Dural on Wednesday 6th May 2020. Although this has not as yet been cancelled, it is highly unlikely to continue, given the restrictions in place due to COVID 19.

Sporting Schools Program: Our final basketball session should still be going ahead this Friday unless we hear otherwise. Our students are truly enjoying these sessions and really appreciate the interest and expertise delivered by Chloe and Shoan.

Parent Information Evening: Thank you so much to those parents who were able to attend our parent information session. As a staff we were delighted to combine and share this information with you and truly appreciate the wonderfully positive feedback received.

Student Learning Resources: Thank you to those who have already made prompt payments of these resources. We ask that you pay these as soon as is possible and remind you that if anyone is experiencing any difficulty with payment to please make an appointment to speak with Mrs Mills so that a payment plan can be set up to assist.

Attendance: It is a requirement that all students are in attendance every school day. If your child is unwell, we ask that you please notify the school by ringing or emailing, if possible, and that a written note confirming this absence is sent upon the student's return. Any absence due to illness longer than 2 days will require a doctor's certificate. Late arrivals and early departures are required to be signed in/out at the front office by the parent/carer. I also remind you that should your child present with flu-like symptoms/ fever, please keep them at home until they are well.

School Hours: The bell rings at 9:00am each day for a 9:05 start. Students are allowed to be dropped off at school from 8:35am each day. The school bell rings at 3:05pm. Parents are asked to pick up their children at this time. No child is allowed to play after school and the play equipment is completely out of bounds to children before and after school. All students waiting for pick-up are requested to wait on the K/1/2 verandah where they can be sheltered and supervised until they leave.

Harmony Day: On Friday of this week we will be participating in Harmony Day activities, celebrating the richness and diversity shared by other cultures. Students will participate in a 50 minute multicultural dance session (in their own class groups). After this teachers have organized other Literacy and Arts activities. *We believe that this will still be taking place at this stage, unless we hear otherwise from Footsteps Dance.*
