## We're ALL Coming Back!!!

We're excited about our return to face-to-face learning and welcoming students and staff back onsite where we know the best learning happens. This is a short summary of what our parents and students can expect.

Due to the size of our school our DEL has agreed that we can <u>all</u> recommence our Learning on site as of Monday 18th October. So we welcome all of our students from Kindy through to Year 6 back to school next week. As such, there will be no need to pick up packages... just drop off your wonderful children and come back to pick them up at 3:05. Please remember that NO PARENT or Carer is allowed on site until further notice. Pick up and drop off will remain as before. We ask that you continue to do this promptly and not congregate , thus allowing minimal contact for everyone's safety.

**Our COVID-safe return** to school plan is NSW Health approved and includes numerous effective practices to support the health and wellbeing of our students and staff. These practices include vaccinations, mask wearing, reduced mingling of student groups and staff, ventilation in classrooms and continued good hygiene and cleaning.

**Masks** are required to be worn on school site by staff indoors and outdoors and is strongly recommended for students indoors and outdoors unless exercising or eating ...**but please note that this is not mandatory for our students.** 

Having open or well-ventilated spaces reduces the risk of transmission of COVID-19 because infectious particles are more quickly diffused in the open air. Please know that our classrooms are all well-ventilated.

During Term 4 many school-based activities will remain on hold until NSW Health advise otherwise. This includes large celebrations like assemblies, presentation days and graduations, arts and sports events.

Parents and students will be notified if a decision is made to close the school due to a confirmed case of COVID-19. During this time we will continue to provide learning from home activities and we will let you know when we can return to face-to-face learning.

**Bus Services:** All Hills Bus school services will recommence from Monday 18th October 2021.

**Communication:** Please continue to check your emails, especially over the school holidays, as it is our main form of communication, to keep you updated and informed, especially if things change suddenly.

**Reports:** Our end of year reports will be modified versions, similar to last year's semester 1 reports. Please note that these will contain no grading of students but will discuss student progress and participation in their learning both during Learning from Home and at school.


