NAPLAN Results: Congratulations to our students in Years 3 and 5 who participated in the NAPLAN assessments earlier this year. Our results were most pleasing with some significant growth noted in the Year 5 cohort. Great work Mrs McLennan on ensuring these students are developing essential Literacy and Numeracy skills.

Yarning Circle: Tomorrow (Wednesday) we will be having the trees in this area deadheaded and saplings removed to ensure that this area is safe for our students. McArdles will be working in this area from around 10am to 3pm. Please be mindful of this when picking up your children at the end of the day.

Student Fees: A reminder that student fees are well and truly due (in fact overdue). **COVID News:** Teachers are now permitted to wear masks inside only as long as they carry one with them when outdoors in case its needed. Students are still expected to be washing their hands before eating and this is a regular practice supervised by staff to ensure all students are mindful of this. Hand sanitiser, wipes and soap are all provided and our cleaner ensures our bathrooms, desks and other surfaces are clean throughout the day.
