Zoo excursion: A great excursion in spite of it being the only cold wet day that week! This zoo is a very comfortable walk around. Our students were excited, interested and so well behaved... as were the teachers! Luckily any rain encountered was very light and had no impact on our viewing of the delightful zoo inhabitants. The excursion has generated many discussions and stimulated various writing activities, and was a great way to enhance our learning across curriculum areas.

Reports: Your child's half-yearly report is intended to be sent home on Thursday of next week. We will be requesting an interview with you if your child has received extra support because of the COVID funding or is on our NCCD list. As we had interviews in Term 1, we do not expect that interviews will be required this term. If, however, you feel that after reading the report that you do need an interview, please contact the office for this to be arranged at a mutually convenient time.

Please remember if at any time you have any concerns, you may telephone for a face to face appointment or request a phone conversation with your child's teacher.

Absences: If you know your child is going to be away ahead of time, we ask that you notify us, in writing, for medical appointments or requesting leave for time away. This allows the class teacher to modify times for assessments and introduction of new work.

School Photos: Our school photos will be taken on the first Thursday back after the holidays. Thursday 15th July. Students will be in full winter uniform for this which includes black shoes. All photo envelopes have been given to the students. The envelopes need to be returned to school beforehand or on the day with the correct money, there is no change available.

Premiers Sporting Challenge: The school has registered for the 2021 Premier's Sporting Challenge (PSC). Students and Staff will be completing a 10 week Challenge before the end of Term 3. The Challenge encourages all students and staff in all schools to be "more active, more often". We already provide a range of opportunities for our students to be active-as part of our PE and Sport, as well as additional activities during other lessons and at break times, the 10 Week challenge will encourage us even further. Students in K/1/2 will be able to track their progress using their class e-Wall Chart and students in 3 to 6 can record their results using their log books. These provide a visual record of weekly physical activity and an opportunity to discuss the benefits of being active and establishing healthy habits. We are awaiting our PSC pack to be sent out.
