More RATs...

Rapid Antigen Tests: We have been instructed to provide every family with 8 RATs per child. These will be for parents to use at their discretion throughout the rest of term 1. No longer is there a requirement for students to be tested 2x per week. So your final batch of RATs will be available on Wednesday or Thursday afternoon. Please contact the school to arrange for your pick up time. If you would like them to be sent home in your child's bag then you will need to <u>email the school</u> to request this action.

Leadership Course: Yr 5/6 are very fortunate to be a part of a Leadership course run by Longneck Lagoon. As we are not allowed to mix with students from other schools as yet, the teacher administering the course has agreed to come to us. The cost for this experience is \$10 per student. This is a full day program for our senior students (Yrs 5/6 only) and encourage all of our senior students to participate.

Footsteps: Every year, as part of our PDHPE program, we engage experienced Dance teachers to carry out a 5 week Dance program with ALL of our students (K-6) on a Tuesday afternoon. Notes were sent home last week. We please ask that notes and money be returned to school this week. First lesson commences next Tuesday.


- Next P&C Meeting: is Tuesday 8th March at 7pm in the school library. Parents attending are required to be vaccinated and sign in using the school QR code.
