Soccer Clinics: Thanks to the Sporting Schools Grants our students will be experiencing soccer clinic sessions each Friday morning from experienced soccer coaches. Leadership Program: Yr 5/6 are very fortunate to be a part of a Leadership Program run by Longneck Lagoon on Monday 6th June, 2022. As we are now allowed to mix with students from other schools, we will be sharing a bus with Hillside PS and attending the Longneck Lagoon Environmental Centre. The original cost for this experience was \$10 per student which many of you have already paid. The school will cover the additional cost of the bus travel. This is a full day program for our senior students (Yrs 5/6 only) and encourage all of our senior students to participate.

Assessments: Assessments will be underway over the next few weeks in readiness for your child's Semester 1 Report. Please ensure all students are attending. Reports will be sent home in Week 9.
