*Swim Scheme:* Last week before this valuable program commences!! We are hoping to involve as many of our students as possible K-6. Swimming is such a vital skill for all of our students, particularly when we live in an area with dams, creeks, rivers and back-yard pools so close. While many children love to splash around in the pool, would they have the knowledge, skill and endurance to save themselves in difficult situations?? The Swim program takes all children through various potential dangers, what to be aware of and what to do about it, at the beginning of every lesson. This is followed by concentrated group tuition each day for ten days at their level. Such a valuable resource at no cost is not to be dismissed. Please consider being a part of this important event.

This annual program run by the Department of Education will be held again at Galston Aquatic Centre for ten school days from Monday 12th November, concluding on Friday 23rd November. We encourage our students to attend this valuable course.
